



CENSORING THEMSELVES

IN ORDER TO AVOID CONFLICT (LIKE PULLING CERTAIN POTENTIALLY INFLAMMATORY TITLES BEFORE THEY'RE ASKED TO, OR CHANGING UP THEIR BOOK BUYING HABITS).

A NUMBER OF LIBRARIANS ARE LEAVING THE PROFESSION ENTIRELY, EITHER DUE TO STAFFING CUTS (ALMOST A 1/3 OF LIBRARIES HAVE LOST STAFF),

# OR BECAUSE THE ATMOSPHERE 15 JUST TOO TOXIC.




